If a legible email address is provided, email confirmation of receipt of entry will be made as soon as possible as entries are received and processed.

Post Dated Checks and Returned Checks do not constitute a valid entry fee. The Obedience/Rally Trial Secretary will add a collection fee of \$25.00 to the amount of each returned check.

No Refund For Duplicate Entries. Every effort will be made to find duplicate entries; however, if the entry has been processed, no refund will be made.

Declination of Entries. No Entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance. Butler Dog Training Association may decline any entries and may remove any dog on account of disease, viciousness, or other cause, and no one shall have any claim against BDTA or any official thereof.

Entry Fees Shall Not Be Refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by a Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of the show committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, weather or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or complete the show, no refund of entries will be made.

Errors On Entry Blanks. Owners are responsible for errors in the filing out of entry forms. No entry and no entry fee will be refunded in the event of such errors, or for cancellation of entries after the published closing date. Please type or print carefully on entry forms to eliminate errors.

Move-up Policy. Obedience and Rally move-ups will be accepted as space permits within entry limits, in accordance with Chapter 1, Section 16 of the Obedience Regulations. Requests for move-ups must be made in writing and presented to trial secretary at least 30 minutes before the start of each Trial.

Bitches In Season will not be admitted to the Trial. Any exhibitor with an entered bitch in season on the Trial date will be refunded the entry fee less \$5.00 upon written certification by a veterinarian given to the Trial Secretary before the start of judging each trial.

Exhibitors are Responsible for the Behavior of Their Dogs and/or Children. All dogs present must be held on leash or confined to their crates except when being judged or when in the exercising area. Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dogs. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create unnecessary disturbances or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the Show Committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any entry fees will be made.

Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. Dogs may arrive any time prior to their scheduled time of judging. Dogs not required for further judging will be excused.

Due to limited space, crating in designated areas only. **Un-entered dogs will not be admitted to the trial.** Exhibitors may be asked to stack crates at BDTA discretion. The Hall will not be available to the exhibitors the night before the Trial.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarians' recommendation to assure their dogs are free of external parasites, any communicable diseases and have appropriate vaccinations.
